Driving Question: What does it mean to be a competent driver?

Course Description: Learner's Driver Ed. 8 (Fee: no cost)

The main focus of this option is to understand what it means to be a competent driver and feel comfortable to take a class 7 driver's test. The aim of this option class is to learn the material in the Learner's Driver's Guide, to ensure students are more prepared when they take the Government's Class 7 test. Students will gain a better understanding of the laws of driving, rules of the road, how to read road signs, and learn the importance of limiting distractions while driving. through the use of video, engaging hands on activities and more, students will cover the content within the Alberta Basic Driver's handbook.

The option is held in a <u>classroom setting only</u>. There will be no In-Vehicle instruction for this option class. Once students turn 14 years old they may take the Government's Class 7 test on their own time at their own cost. Ecole Fox Run School does not offer the Government's Class 7 test.

The AMA website will be used in order to practice taking the test, although there are many other practice test websites. The students will spend some time practicing for the multiple choice test in the classroom.
