

Grade 8 Renaissance Course Outline

In this complementary course you will be introduced to the leadership activities and the culture of Ecole Fox Run School. The vision is to create a Renaissance school where academic excellence, continuous improvement, school spirit and citizenship is promoted and recognised. Renaissance is a process that empowers students, staff, and community members to work together to enhance student achievement, celebrate success and increase student activity and community involvement in schools.

In the Renaissance complementary students will work on a variety of activities. Students plan activities to promote school culture and collaborate to achieve their goals. They work in many groups exploring leadership skills and school involvement.
